(Children are formed in a circle. One child is chosen to be a cat and takes position outside the circle, and another one to be a mouse and is positioned in the circle. Children are imitating what they're chanting.)

I LIKE RUNNING

I LIKE JUMPING

I LIKE CRAWLING

AROUND THE HOUSE

I LIKE EATING

I LIKE SLEEPING

I LIKE CATCHING ...

THE BIG WHITE MOUSE!

(At the last sentence children hold their hands together in order to protect the mouse which is hiding in the circle. The cat is trying to break into the circle through the gaps between the children trying to catch the mouse. Children are using their hands to obstruct the cat's way in. If, however, the cat succeeds to break through, then the children let the mouse out and try to keep the cat in ... When the cat catches the mouse, the mouse becomes a cat and another child is chosen to be a mouse. The chant is repeated ...)
